Under the direction of the Director of Process Development and Manufacturing, this position is expected to manage incoming raw material receipt and release for internal and external manufacturing operations, facilitate quality control (QC) testing of materials and products, and operation of Fate's Manufacturing laboratories including equipment and monitoring. Fate's development programs involve novel cell therapeutic products which present unique product manufacturing and quality opportunities. The ideal candidate will have experience in raw material management and laboratory operations. Cell therapy manufacturing knowledge and familiarity with the pertinent regulations and how they apply to this field is desired. This is a full-time position currently reporting to the Director of Process Development and Manufacturing and is located at our corporate headquarters in San Diego, CA.
